ELIGIBILITY FOR TITLE IV FUNDING

**POLICY:**

Students must meet Title IV funding eligibility requirements prior to being certified for Stafford/PLUS loans or Pell Grants.

1. The Title IV funding eligibility requirements are:
  - a) Enrolled full time in an approved school.
  - b) U.S. citizen, national/permanent resident, or other eligible non-resident.
  - c) High School diploma or recognized equivalent.
  - d) Making satisfactory academic progress.
  - e) If required, registered with the Selective Service.
  - f) Not in default on a Title IV loan (Stafford/PLUS).
  - g) Does not owe a repayment of a Title IV grant (Pell/SEOG).
  - h) Does not already have a bachelor's degree.(Pell Grant)
  - i) Signs statement of educational purpose, agrees to use funds only for school-related expenses.
  - j) Has not borrowed in excess of federal loan limits.
  - k) Has not been convicted for possession of illegal drugs.
  - l) Provides FAO with necessary data for verification (Income Tax Returns, W2's, etc) as required.
